

ORDINANCE NO. 2022.05.16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WORTH COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE, AS ADOPTED ON FEBRUARY 9 2009, AND ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO; TO INCLUDE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF SILVER LAKE, BRISTOL, FERTILE, GROVE, KENSETT, LINCOLN, DEER CREEK, BARTON, AND UNION TOWNSHIPS

WHEREAS, Worth County has had in full force a Zoning Ordinance for unincorporated areas of Hartland, Brookfield, and Danville Townships, which establishes and maintains regulations for the purpose of improving and protecting the public health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the people, as well as the use of land within those townships; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of Worth County, after a public hearing, pursuant to due published notice as required by law, on March 29, 2022, recommended approval of said Zoning Ordinance county-wide.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Worth County, Iowa after hearing the recommended approval of said Zoning Ordinance county-wide and holding the Public Hearing at the County Board of Supervisors at the Board of Supervisors Room, pursuant due to published notice as required by law, on June 1 &2, 2022:
