

On Saturday morning, January 19, the Worth County Sheriff's Office conducted a search warrant in rural Manly. As a result of the search warrant authorities located narcotics and drug paraphernalia. Mark Urbatsch, 61, of rural Manly was arrested and charged with possession of a controlled substance-methamphetamine 3rd or subsequent offense, a class D felony, possession of a controlled substance-marijuana 3rd or subsequent offense, an aggravated misdemeanor and possession of drug paraphernalia, a simple misdemeanor. Holly Low, 45, of Northwood was arrested and charged with possession of a controlled substance – methamphetamine 1st offense, a serious misdemeanor, possession of a controlled substance – marijuana 1st offense, a serious misdemeanor and possession of drug paraphernalia, a simple misdemeanor. Both Urbatsch and Low were booked into the Worth County Jail.

Assisting the Worth County Sheriff's Office was the Mitchell County Sheriff's Office K9 unit.

All subjects are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
