

On 10/20/2018 at approximately 0115 hours, a deputy with the Worth County Sheriff's Office conducted a traffic stop at the intersection on Highway 105 and Nettle Ave on a Black 2015 Chevrolet Equinox for failure to dim. As a result of the traffic stop, it was determined that a passenger in the vehicle had given a false name. When the deputy confronted the passenger about giving false identification, the deputy observed a pipe commonly used for smoking methamphetamine with burnt residue on the floor of the passenger seat. As a result of a search of the vehicle, approximately 3 grams a white crystalline substance consistent with methamphetamine was recovered from between the center console and passenger seat of the vehicle, directly next to a wallet containing identification for 40 year Trenton Anderson of Detroit Lakes, MN. Trenton was taken into custody and placed under arrest for possession of drug paraphernalia, possession of a controlled substance (3<sup>rd</sup> or subsequent offence, Class D Felony), a no bond warrant out of Mower County, MN and a warrant out of Eau Claire, Wisconsin. All suspects are innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
