Motion by Hanlontown to approve ESF 10, 12, 14 and RSF 2 as presented. 2nd by Northwood. Motion carried all ayes.

Motion by BOS to renew insurance with ICAP pool. 2nd by Grafton. Budgeted \$5,200 and invoiced at \$5158. Motion carried all ayes.

Discussion on EMA shed repair. Coordinator will contact a vendor to replace the existing gutter with a seamless gutter and down spout(s).

Updates from coordinator

- Kickoff meeting with project coordinator for the Multijurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan update will be May 30th
- Chapter 29C legislation -nothing passed out of the legislation this year. The future is unknown at this time.
- MOC light / camera tower issue. Possibly is an underrated solenoid. Parts to repair are on hand. It will take about an hour to fix if it goes down again. A plan B also was made.
