GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Civilian front escort With mounted height pole Civilian Rear Escort Amber revolving light/strobe light with 360° visibility
- Required on Highway _____ Required entire route
- Law enforcement escort Front Rear
- See General Provisions for escort requirements for overwidth vehicles.
- Centerline all bridges: Non-Interstate roads with posted speeds under 65 mph centerline at 5 mph. Posted speed limits of 65 mph and all Interstate roads centerline at posted speed.
- Load must slow or stop when necessary to avoid approaching traffic when centerlining.
- Hazardous materials must be transported in compliance with applicable federal regulations.
- Run around clearance on route No. _____ Run marked detour on route No. _____
- Signs and Flags must be displayed
- Special Requirement

- Speed Limit - Maximum posted limits unless otherwise specified on permit. Minimum 40 mph interstate.
- Must carry copy of permit and General Provisions dated 08/05 and comply with them.
- Road must be clear of ice and snow and visibility must be at least 1/4 mile.
- No movement allowed on I-235 (Dow Mobies) weekdays from 7 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 8 p.m.
- Necessary city and/or county permits must be obtained separately.
- Round Trip, Return by reverse route within same five days.
