BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that we, the undersigned members of the Board of Supervisors and ex-officio Board of Canvassers of Worth County, Iowa, do hereby certify the following TURNOUT REPORT and RESULTS in the CITY-SCHOOL ELECTION, held November 4, 2025, and that no obvious clerical errors were identified during the canvass.

Eight hundred nine (809) people voted at the polls on election day.

Fifty-one (51) absentee ballots were accepted for counting.

Zero (0) provisional ballots were accepted for counting.

A total of eight hundred sixty (860) people voted.
