Don't Rely on the Luck of the Irish

One of America's favorite holidays, St. Patrick's Day, is March 17, and we continually see a spike in drunk-driving crashes on this date every year. In order to make Iowa roads safer all across the state drivers will notice heightened traffic enforcement March 14 - 17, 2018. Law enforcement officers will especially be watching for drunk drivers and vehicle occupants not wearing a seat belt.

According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA), nationally, during the 2016 St. Patrick's holiday (the latest year numbers are available) 39% of all vehicle crash fatalities involved drunk drivers. In the hours between midnight and 6:00 a.m. on March 18th,69% of all crash fatalities involved drunk drivers.

Drunk driving **IS** preventable! It is not worth the risk of injury, jail time, your death, or the death of another person. No designated driver? Download the NHTSA app, "SaferRide" before going out to celebrate. The app will allow users to call a taxi or designated friend for a ride home by just identifying their location.
